**CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

1. The competition will be held under Pony Club Eventing Rules 2019.
2. For dress and tack rules please visit The Pony Club's website [www.pcuk.org](http://www.pcuk.org) under the appropriate discipline.
3. After the closing date entries will only be accepted at the discretion of the organisers – contact the Secretary for late entry.
4. Total entries may be restricted and will be taken on a first come, first served basis
5. Entries close on Friday 19<sup>th</sup> April 2019 and must be made on [www.equoevents.co.uk](http://www.equoevents.co.uk). Late entry closes Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> April 2019.
6. Times available from the web site <http://branches.pcuk.org/fife/> on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> April. No refunds after times posted.
7. In case of cancellation the organisers reserve the right to retain a £10 administration fee.
8. The course may be walked from 2pm on Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> April, starting times will be posted at the Secretary's tent from 2pm.
9. There will be "L" Fences (which will incur a penalty) at the more difficult fences on all courses. Except BRC classes where no alternative fences may be jumped.
10. Crash hats must bear the BSI Kite Mark with either PAS 015:1998, PAS 015:2011 or VG1, Snell E2001 onwards with official Snell label and number or ASTM-F1163 2004a with SEI mark. Hats must be worn, with the chin strap fastened, at all times when mounted. A hat cover shall be worn for each phase. A hat without a fixed peak shall be worn for the XC phase. Details are given in Clause 8a) i) of the 2019 Eventing Rule book available on The Pony Club's website [www.pcuk.org](http://www.pcuk.org) under "For Officials – Rules and Guidance", Rules & Rulebooks, Eventing.
11. Tack checks will take place when the competitor presents for each phase. It is the competitor's responsibility to have the correct tack and be suitably attired to meet the standards as shown in PC Eventing Rules 2019.
12. An approved body protector must be worn for the Cross-Country phase and must meet **BETA 2009 Level 3 standard (2009 Purple or 2018 Blue labels)**. Details are given in Clause 8a) viii) of the 2019 Eventing Rule book available on The Pony Club's website [www.pcuk.org](http://www.pcuk.org) under "For Officials – Rules and Guidance" Rules & Rulebooks Eventing.
13. Medical armbands are recommended at all times and should be worn on the arm, but are not compulsory, except BRC classes, where medical armbands are compulsory.
14. No recording devices are permitted (e.g hat/bridle cameras)
15. All hats being worn during the ODE **must** be presented at the Secretaries tent for checking/tagging when registering.
16. If a competitor is wearing an Air Jacket, please bring your own number bib and print off your own number and register with the Secretary.
17. Any objections to be accompanied by a £20 deposit.
18. Dogs must be kept on a lead at ALL times – offenders will be required to make a donation of £25 to charity.
19. Rosettes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> in each class, and for 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> in the Dressage phase of each class.
20. **Riders must be properly attired for the Prize Giving and are expected to attend.**
21. NON-PONY CLUB MEMBERS SHOULD ENSURE THAT THEY ARE COVERED FOR THIRD PARTY PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE.
22. Please see the separate document entitled BE Vaccination Rules 2019 which will govern this event.

A Farrier has been booked to be present on the field for the day.

Catering will also be available on the field for the day.

A list of those who can provide Stabling has been prepared and is available on the FPC website or from the Secretary. All stabling requests should be made directly to the provider by the competitor.

**LEGAL LIABILITY.**

1. Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
2. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.
3. All non Pony Club competitors are not covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third party cover. The Fife Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non Members and their insurance will not cover you.

**Rules for the South Cup.** The South Cup Trophy will be won by a team of three members from one Pony Club branch, each member from a different age-group, with the best cumulative score. The team members are not pre-chosen. The age groups are 17 and over, 15 and 16 years, 13 and 14 years, 12 and under, ages of all competitors taken as at 1 January 2019. There are Open and Novice classes for each age group, but only one member from each age group (either open or novice) will count towards the team score. For members to count they must be entered in a Pony Club Class and have stated their age on the entry form. The South Cup is competed for by teams of three from Pony Clubs in Area 1 who don't compete for the North Cup and from Area 19.
