RULES FOR THE DRESSAGE LEAGUE 2019

1. Entries cancelled by the withdrawal date will have their entry fee refunded. Late withdrawals will forfeit their entry fee.
2. Rosettes will be awarded from 1st to 6th.
3. **The judges decision is final**
4. Stewards and Organisers must be obeyed at all times
5. This competition will be run under British Riding Club Rules with the addition of the rules below.
6. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Entries Secretary. **NO TELEPHONE OR FACEBOOK ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AND NO ENTRIES ACCEPTED WITHOUT CORRECT REMITTANCE.**
7. Number bibs must be collected and worn
8. The Organiser reserves the right to decline any entry, combine, divide, or cancel any class, if there are insufficient entries.
9. At or in the vicinity of any Riding Club event, everyone mounted, whether competing or not must wear a hard hat conforming to the minimum safety standards, with a harness properly adjusted and fastened. Failure to do so will incur elimination of the horse and/or rider from the competition. Hats must be marked to standard as per BRC rules. Where a hat is of skull cap style, this must be worn with a plain silk.
10. Moray Riding Club do not accept any liability for accident or damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other persons or property. Medical cover will be First Aiders. It is the competitors responsibility to ensure they are adequately insured.
11. Horses/ponies may only compete at two consecutive levels, i.e. preliminary and novice, novice and elementary.
12. Horses competing **MUST NOT BE LUNGED** in the warm up school at dressage competitions.
13. The Committee reserve the right to amalgamate, alter or cancel any of the above classes. The right is also reserved to transfer entries if, in the opinion of the Committee, they are entered in the wrong class. Classes will be split into adults and juniors if entries warrant.
14. The making of an entry implies acceptance of the conditions above

League Points

There will be one class in each section, which will be a point's class. League classes are highlighted in the schedule.

League placings will be awarded to Moray Riding Club Members **ONLY** who have entered a minimum of 3 competitions throughout the league

Points will be awarded on a percentage basis as follows:

- Up to 50% - 1 point
- Up to 53% - 2 points
- Up to 55% - 3 points
- Up to 58% - 4 points
- Up to 61% - 5 points
- Up to 64% - 6 points
- Up to 67% - 7 points
- Up to 70% - 8 points
- Up to 73% - 9 points
- Over 73% - 10 points

If at the end of the League there is equality of points in any of the sections, for example two people placed second equal on points in a league, then second and third places will be decided using the

following criteria: Attendance at league competitions. If one competitor has attended more of the current series of league competitions than the other then second place will go to the person who has attended most and third place will go to the person who has attended less.

Entry Fees

£6 per class for Moray Riding Club members.

£8 per class for members of other affiliated riding/pony clubs aged 12 or over.
